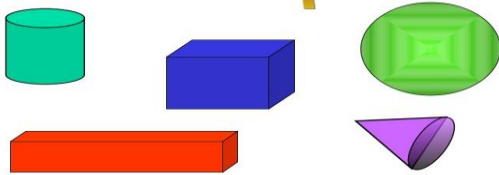

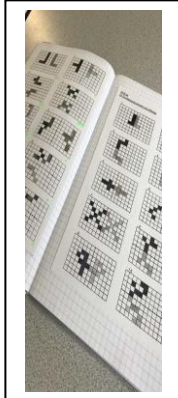

Year 4: Year 4 have had a very busy final week of the half term. Maths has been very practical as we have looked at lines of symmetry and reflection. The children were using their problem solving skills to find the other half of a diagram. We are coming to the end of our speeches, the children have tried very hard and we can't wait to read them aloud. Our afternoons have been packed full of topic work and we have played rounders outside in PE.



Year 5: This week in Year Five we have completed our letters to Miss Taylor and the children are looking forward to reading her response after half term. In Maths, the children have focused this week on shape, angles and properties of a rectangle – this proved difficult at first but the children are beginning to show some great resilience when tackling problem-solving questions. We ended the week playing kwik cricket, which the children loved.
