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The 2020-2021 funding has been used in a variety of ways to further improve and develop teaching and learning across the whole academy. We have encouraged pupils to continue to lead healthy lifestyles, enjoy PE and Sport and experience high quality teaching. They have been encouraged to take part in competitions and aim for sporting excellence. We have a strong commitment to support teachers to develop their skills and knowledge to enhance the quality of the teaching of physical education. Through monitoring and evaluation, the academy recognises the positive impact on the quality of teaching of PE and the need to use our funding in different ways.

Learning walks, lesson visits and monitoring by SLT and the PE leader as well as a termly PE report, have identified the following areas to address in PE this year: high quality resources to support the demands of PE, increased awareness of healthy lifestyles, increased quality of warmups and agility games to build up stamina. Due to Covid 19 and the alternative arrangements introduced for educational establishments, the amount allocated was not fully utilised.
