

## Homework Policy

Homework will be sent home with all children, FS2 to Year 6, every Friday. This is to be completed and returned to school by Thursday of the following week. Amounts of homework and expectations are detailed below.

### Homework expectations

<p><b>Reading</b></p>	<p>Children receiving reading support will take home an appropriately pitched home reading text.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Phonics</b> – Book matching GPC</li> <li>▪ <b>Fluent readers</b> – Book of own choice from early fluency selection.</li> </ul> <p>A reading for pleasure text</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ A text chosen from the school library by the child. This may also be the child's reading book for fluent readers. For phonics readers, this text may be a paired reader or sharing text.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Phonics</b></p>	<p>Additional phonics booklets, flashcards and worksheets may be sent home through the year to support your child's development in reading.</p>
<p><b>Maths</b></p>	<p>An appropriately pitched, subject related maths task (that reviews prior learning) that children can complete independently, or with a level of support appropriate for home learning.</p>
<p><b>Spellings</b></p>	<p>Spelling shed homework sheet, inline with long term plan and spellings currently being taught.</p>
